- (If chosen trade is not listed here, please advise as to the local need for the trade chosen.)
- Have or had a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent)

Individuals pursuing degrees/certificates in service industries such as culinary arts, cosmetology, or hospitality are ineligible.

#### Award information:

- If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award in the amount of that year's award funds available. (Varies among years)
- H&H may decide to divide the award amongst qualifying applicants
- Awards are one-time only. Past recipients may not re-apply
- Awards are for Crittenden County High School Seniors only

## Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of:

- Trade essay
- Demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities
- Work experience (or demonstrate equivalent)
- Statement of educational and career goals and objectives
- Unusual personal or family circumstances demonstrating need
- Consideration of academic record

Financial need will be considered. Recipients must demonstrate need if need exists.

## As part of your application, you must include the following document(s):

- A current, complete transcript of grades. Grade reports are not accepted. Unofficial or online transcripts must display student name, school name, grades and credit hours for each course and term in which each course was taken
- ONE letter of recommendation from anyone in the local community (must not be a family member)
- Your Trade Essay

Your application is not complete unless all required documents are submitted.
